**CANARIES EDGE GOLDEYES:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes lost 4-3 to the Sioux Falls Canaries at Shaw Park on Sunday afternoon. Clint Coulter broke a 3-3 tie with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the seventh inning. Canaries' reliever Will Solomon pitched 3.1 scoreless innings to close out the game. Goldeyes' starter Mitchell Lambson took the loss, allowing four earned runs on 11 hits in 8.0 innings. Lambson walked one and struck out four. Winnipeg took a 2-0 lead in the first on a Dominic Ficociello sacrifice fly and a Jonathan Moroney two-out, RBI single. Coulter singled home a run in the top of the fourth, while Alay Lago's two-out, RBI double in the fifth tied the game. Reggie Abercrombie hit a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth to put Winnipeg ahead before Michael Hart tied the game with a solo shot in the top of the sixth. Moroney had four hits.

**ALL-TIME AGAINST THE CANARIES:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 168-107 all-time against the Sioux Falls Canaries, including an 88-51 record in home games, and a 69-37 record at Shaw Park. The Canaries were one of the original six members of the Northern League during the birth of modern independent baseball in 1993. The Canaries, St. Paul Saints, and Sioux City Explorers are the three longest-tenured independent teams still operating in their original cities. The Canaries joined the American Association as a charter member in 2006, and won their first league championship in 2008. The Canaries rebranded themselves as the Sioux Falls Pheasants in 2010, and made a return trip to the American Association Championship Series that same season. The club changed its name back to the Canaries in 2013. Mike Meyer is in his third year as Canaries' manager. Meyer served as hitting coach for the Laredo Lemurs from 2015-16, which included the Lemurs' 2015 American Association championship campaign. Meyer previously served as Sioux Falls' pitching coach from 2007-14. Meyer was 42-39 with six saves and a 4.20 ERA during an eight-year playing career, and was part of the Saints' 2004 Northern League championship club. Former Goldeyes' right-hander Ben Moore returns as Meyer's pitching coach. Moore was 15-11 for the Goldeyes from 2006-07, and holds the American Association career record for both wins (55) and strikeouts (701). The Canaries retired Moore's number "25" on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Goldeyes' centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie starred for Sioux Falls from 2010-13, hitting 54 of his American Association record 146 home runs. On June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014, five Goldeyes' pitchers combined to no-hit the Canaries in the nightcap of a double header at Sioux Falls Stadium. The Canaries beat the Goldeyes 14-5 in the first ever game at Shaw Park on June 4<sup>th</sup>, 1999.

**SERIES MATCHUP:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 56-43, in fourth place in the American Association North Division, and eliminated from postseason contention. The Goldeyes just swept the Gary SouthShore RailCats in a three-game series at Shaw Park. The Goldeyes are tied for sixth in the American Association in hitting (.273), 10<sup>th</sup> in pitching (4.56), and first in fielding (.987). The Sioux Falls Canaries are 38-61, in fifth place in the South Division, and also eliminated from contention. The Canaries were just swept in a three-game series by the Sioux City Explorers at Sioux Falls Stadium. The Canaries are third in the league in batting (.283), 11<sup>th</sup> in pitching (5.74), and tied for seventh in defence (.978). This is the third of three head-to-head series this season between Winnipeg and Sioux Falls. The Goldeyes are 5-4 against the Canaries this season.

### PROJECTED UPCOMING PITCHING MATCHUPS

\*\*\*End of 2019 Regular Season\*\*\*

**TONIGHT'S STARTERS:** The Goldeyes go with right-hander Parker French who is 5-6 with a 5.45 ERA in 17 starts and four relief appearances this season. French took a no-decision vs. Gary SouthShore on Wednesday, allowing two earned runs on four hits in 7.0 innings. French walked five and struck out two. The Goldeyes won

the game 3-2.

French was 1-4 with a 7.95 ERA last season in eight starts and 19 relief appearances for the Double-A Eastern League's Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies). French was 8-11 with a 6.37 ERA for the Yard Goats in 2017, and allowed four or fewer earned runs in 16 of his 24 starts. In 2016, French led the High-A California League with a 2.85 ERA while pitching for the Modesto Nuts. No qualifying California League pitcher has matched that ERA since.

French is in his fifth season of professional baseball, and is 26-35 lifetime with a 4.84 ERA in 110 appearances, 87 of them as a starting pitcher. French has walked two batters or less in 66 of his 87 career starts. Entering 2019, French owned a 1.66 ground-out-to-air-out ratio (the 2018 Major League average was 1.03). French was drafted by the Rockies in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Texas at Austin (Austin, Texas). French was a combined 22-15 with a 2.60 ERA for the Texas Longhorns from 2012-15, and served as their "Friday Night Starter" as a sophomore in 2013.

French is 1-0 with a 4.76 ERA in two career starts against Sioux Falls. French is 4-3 with a 4.64 ERA in nine starts and one relief appearance in his career at Shaw Park.

The Canaries go with right-hander Alex Boshers who is 6-8 with a 5.92 ERA in 20 starts and one relief appearance this season. Boshers took a complete game loss vs. Sioux City on Wednesday, allowing nine runs, eight earned, on 15 hits in 9.0 innings. Boshers walked one and struck out seven. Boshers has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 12 of his 20 starts this season, and has allowed four or fewer earned runs in 15 of them. Boshers has walked two batters or less in 16 of his 20 starts, and has walked three batters or less in 19 of them.

Boshers was 3-10 with a 5.55 ERA in 21 starts and two relief appearances for the Goldeyes last season. Boshers walked two batters or less in 18 of his 21 starts and finished tied for eighth among American Association pitchers in wins above replacement (WAR) at 2.4.

Boshers helped the Wichita Wingnuts reach the American Association Championship Series in back-to-back seasons from 2016-17. Boshers won 12 games in 2016 and 11 more in 2017, which ranked tied for first and tied for fourth in the league respectively.

Boshers is in his fifth season of professional baseball, and is 36-29 lifetime with a 4.44 ERA in 120 games, 78 of them as a starting pitcher. Boshers has averaged just 2.0 walks per nine innings during his career, and has walked two batters or less in 68 of 78 career starts. Boshers pitched five seasons of college baseball at the University of Tennessee-Martin (Martin, Tennessee) from 2010-14 before signing with the Wingnuts as a true rookie in 2015.

The Goldeyes traded Boshers to the Canaries last October 23<sup>rd</sup> in exchange for right-handed pitcher Dylan Thompson. Thompson's contract was purchased by the Boston Red Sox during spring training.

Boshers is 2-1 with a 7.83 ERA in four career regular season starts against Winnipeg. Boshers has also made three starts and one relief appearance in the postseason against Winnipeg, going 1-2 with a 10.91 ERA. Boshers took the loss in the decisive Game Five of the 2016 American Association Championship Series at Wichita's Lawrence-Dumont Stadium on September 19<sup>th</sup>. Boshers is 3-6 with a 5.35 ERA in 13 career regular season starts at Shaw Park.

**GOLDEYES MANAGER:** Rick Forney is now in his 14<sup>th</sup> season as Goldeyes' manager, and his 23<sup>rd</sup> overall within the organization. During his first 13 years at the helm, the Goldeyes have posted a .545 overall winning percentage (698-583), 10 winning seasons, nine playoff appearances, and an American Association-record three championships. Forney was voted American Association Manager of the Year in 2011, and managed the American Association during the American Association/Can-Am League All-Star Game in 2017. Forney's .553 winning percentage in the American Association (2011-18) is the third-highest in league history (there have been 51 total American Association managers through the 2018 season). Forney pitched professionally for 10 years, including four seasons with the Goldeyes. During his playing career, Forney was 89-56 (.614) with a 3.63 ERA, and reached the Triple-A level in 1995.

**YANKEES, DODGERS, GOLDEYES:** With their 51<sup>st</sup> win on August 26<sup>th</sup> at Fargo-Moorhead, the Goldeyes clinched the 22<sup>nd</sup> winning season in the club's 26-year history. Since beginning play in 1994, the Goldeyes 22 winning seasons are the most of any team in independent baseball, and rank third in all of professional baseball. Entering this year, only the New York Yankees (25) and Los Angeles Dodgers (22) had more winning seasons than the Goldeyes since 1994.

**GOLDEYES ELIMINATED:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes were mathematically eliminated from postseason contention on Saturday, August 24<sup>th</sup>. It marks only the second time in the Goldeyes' 26-year history in which they will miss the playoffs in consecutive years. The Goldeyes last missed the postseason in back-to-back years in 2004 and 2005.

**LAMBSON VOTED PITCHER OF THE YEAR:** Goldeyes' left-hander Mitchell Lambson has been voted the American Association's 2019 Pitcher of the Year. Lambson leads the American Association in wins (13), ranks fifth in ERA (3.11), second in strikeouts (133), first in innings pitched (150.2), and first in complete games (four). Nick Hernandez was the last Goldeye to win the award (2014).

**ABERCROMBIE SETS FRANCHISE HOME RUN RECORD:** Centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie hit his 91<sup>st</sup> home run as a Goldeye on August 31<sup>st</sup> vs. Sioux Falls, passing Josh Mazzola for the franchise career record. Abercrombie tied Mazzola with his 90<sup>th</sup> Goldeyes' home run on August 28<sup>th</sup> vs. Gary SouthShore.

**ABERCROMBIE TIES DUVA:** Reggie Abercrombie tied the Goldeyes' career runs scored record on September 1<sup>st</sup> vs. Sioux Falls. Abercrombie's run on a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth was his 370<sup>th</sup> as a Goldeye, tying Brian Duva for first place.

**MCGOVERN RECEIVES OPPORTUNITY IN ATLANTIC LEAGUE:** Goldeyes' left-handed pitcher Kevin McGovern was traded to the Atlantic League's Southern Maryland Blue Crabs on August 30<sup>th</sup> in exchange for future considerations. McGovern concludes his American Association season 12-7 with a 3.85 ERA in 20 starts and one relief appearance. The Atlantic League plays a 140-game schedule that runs through late-September.

**HISTORIC DEFENCE:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes lead the American Association with a .987 team fielding percentage. The American Association record is .982, set by the 2017 Lincoln Saltdogs.

**LAMBSON SETS INNINGS MARK:** Goldeyes' left-hander Mitchell Lambson broke the club's single-season record for innings pitched on September 1<sup>st</sup> vs. Sioux Falls. Lambson worked 8.0 innings to run his season total to 150.2. The previous record was 149.0 innings shared by Roger Luque (2004) and Andrew "Ace" Walker (2009).

**LAMBSON GOING THE DISTANCE:** Goldeyes' all-star left-hander Mitchell Lambson has pitched four complete games this season. The four complete games lead the American Association, and also rank tied for third on the Goldeyes' single-season list. Andrew "Ace" Walker holds the Goldeyes' single-season record with six complete games in 2009. Joey Cramblitt ranks second with five complete games in 2003. Lambson also has seven complete games with the Goldeyes over the last two years, which ranks tied for third on the club's career list.

**INNINGS EATERS:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes' starting rotation features three pitchers that are among the American Association leaders in innings pitched. Mitchell Lambson ranks first (150.2), Kevin Hilton is third (133.0), and Kevin McGovern is sixth (126.1). 97.1 of Hilton's innings came with the Texas AirHogs.

**MCGOVERN SETS GOLDEYES STRIKEOUT RECORD:** Goldeyes' fourth-year left-handed pitcher Kevin McGovern set the franchise career strikeout record on July 24<sup>th</sup> vs. Texas. McGovern struck out AirHogs' second baseman Luo Jinjun in the top of the second inning for his 436<sup>th</sup> in a Goldeyes' uniform. Left-hander Chris Salamida (2010-14) held the previous record with 435 strikeouts. On May 26<sup>th</sup> vs. Kansas City, McGovern struck out 11 batters. His fifth that afternoon was his 381<sup>st</sup> as a Goldeye, moving him ahead of Andrew "Ace" Walker for second place. McGovern was traded to the Atlantic League's Southern Maryland Blue Crabs on August 30<sup>th</sup>. His Goldeyes' record stands at 467 strikeouts.

**THREE MAJOR RECORDS FOR CAPELLAN:** Fourth-year Goldeyes' relief pitcher Victor Capellan earned his 38<sup>th</sup> save with the club on June 11<sup>th</sup> at Gary SouthShore, setting a new franchise career record. Steve Thomas (2001-03) held the previous record with 37 saves. On August 2<sup>nd</sup> at Fargo-Moorhead, Capellan earned his 23<sup>rd</sup> save of 2019, setting a new Goldeyes' single-season record. The previous record of 22 was shared by Capellan (2018) and Oscar Montero (2004). On July 8<sup>th</sup> vs. St. Paul, Capellan made his 221<sup>st</sup> career appearance in the American Association, passing right-hander Dustin Cameron for the league's all-time record. On July 25<sup>th</sup> vs. Texas, Capellan earned his 20<sup>th</sup> save of the season, and became just the eighth pitcher in American Association history to post a second season of 20-plus saves. Capellan appeared in all 12 of the Goldeyes' postseason victories from 2016-17.

**DARVILL SETTLING IN AT SHORT:** Goldeyes' veteran infielder Wes Darvill has seen extensive playing time at shortstop this season. Darvill has a .990 fielding percentage and has committed just two errors in 47 games at shortstop. Darvill also has a .967 fielding percentage with just two errors in 41 games at third base this season. From 2016-17, Darvill fielded more chances (532) than any third baseman in the American Association.

**STEADY AT SECOND:** Goldeyes' second baseman Alex Perez leads the American Association with a .994 fielding percentage in 97 games. Perez has also fielded the most chances at the position (469), and did not commit an error in his first 55 games. Perez's first error came on July 18<sup>th</sup> vs. Sioux Falls.

**ABCRCROMBIE SETS GOLDEYES RBI RECORD:** With a two-out, two-run double in the bottom of the sixth on July 3<sup>rd</sup> vs. Fargo-Moorhead, centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie moved into first place on the Goldeyes' career RBI list with his 347<sup>th</sup> and 348<sup>th</sup> since joining the club in 2014. Longtime catcher Luis Alen established the previous record in 2015 with 347.

**ABCRCROMBIE SETS LEAGUE RUNS RECORD:** Reggie Abercrombie scored on Tyler Hill's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh inning on July 24<sup>th</sup> vs. Texas. It was Abercrombie's 530<sup>th</sup> career run in the American Association, setting a new league record. David Espinosa held the previous mark with 529 runs scored. Abercrombie tied Espinosa after hitting a solo home run on July 20<sup>th</sup> at Kansas City.

**ANOTHER RECORD FOR REGGIE:** Goldeyes' centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie set the American Association's all-time record for games played on May 29<sup>th</sup> vs. Gary SouthShore. Abercrombie appeared in his 694<sup>th</sup> game since joining the league in 2010, passing former Goldeye Josh Mazzola.

**ABCRCROMBIE PASSES PENPRASE:** Goldeyes' centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie stole second base in the first inning on June 20<sup>th</sup> vs. Chicago. It was Abercrombie's 170<sup>th</sup> stolen base during his time in the American Association, which moved him past former Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks' shortstop Zach Penprase for third all-time. Abercrombie tied Penprase with his 169<sup>th</sup> American Association steal on June 19<sup>th</sup> vs. Chicago. Former Goldeye Maikol Gonzalez holds the league's career record with 230 steals, while Brian Fryer is second at 206.

**TENURED REGGIE:** On May 16<sup>th</sup> at Texas, Goldeyes' centre fielder Reggie Abercrombie became the first player in American Association history to appear in a 10<sup>th</sup> season. Abercrombie first joined the league in 2010 with the Sioux Falls Pheasants.

**PLAYOFF FORMAT:** The American Association maintains the two-division format that was re-introduced in 2018. Both divisions feature six teams. The Goldeyes remain in the American Association North along with the Chicago Dogs, Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, Gary SouthShore RailCats, Milwaukee Milkmen, and the St. Paul Saints. The Sioux Falls Canaries move to the South Division, and are joined by the Cleburne Railroaders, Kansas City T-Bones, Lincoln Saltdogs, Sioux City Explorers, and Texas AirHogs.

**DAIRY DELIVERY:** The American Association welcomes the Milwaukee Milkmen as an expansion team in 2019. The franchise is based out of Franklin, Wisconsin, a suburb located 14 miles southwest of downtown Milwaukee. The Milkmen will play at brand new Routine Field, a \$15 Million development with an expected capacity of 4,000. Inclement weather has delayed construction, and the Milkmen expect to formally open Routine Field on June 24<sup>th</sup>. The club will play its home games in Kokomo, Indiana during the first month of the season. The Milkmen effectively replace the Wichita Wingnuts who were forced to vacate Lawrence-Dumont Stadium in preparation for the arrival of a Triple-A franchise in 2020.

**GOLDEYES ENTER 26<sup>th</sup> SEASON:** The Winnipeg Goldeyes enter their 26<sup>th</sup> season in 2019. The franchise brought professional baseball back to the city in 1994. The Goldeyes were 41-59 in 2018, marking just the fourth time in team history they finished below .500. The Goldeyes have reached the postseason 19 times in their first 25 years, and have won four championships (Northern League 1994, American Association 2012, 2016, 2017).

**ALUMNI REPORT:** RHP Brandon Kintzler (2007-08) has a 2.39 ERA in 52.2 innings for the Chicago Cubs. Kintzler was an American League All-Star in 2017, saving 28 games for the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Washington Nationals in July. Kintzler has pitched in the Major Leagues every season since 2010. RHP Dylan Thompson's contract was purchased by the Boston Red Sox on May 10<sup>th</sup>, and is 6-8 with a 5.34 ERA in 16 starts and three relief appearances for the High-A Carolina League's Salem Red Sox. Earlier this season, Thompson earned a promotion to Double-A Portland where he picked up the win in his first career Double-A start. RHP Brandon Marklund signed with the Goldeyes in January as a true rookie before having his contract purchased by the Kansas City Royals one week later. Marklund has a 0.46 ERA in 39.1 innings for the Low-A South Atlantic League's Lexington Legends. Infielder Kevin Lachance had his contract purchased by the Arizona Diamondbacks on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Lachance is currently with the Short Season-A Northwest League's Hillsboro Hops. Lachance also earned a promotion to the Triple-A Pacific Coast League's Reno Aces. Outfielder Tyler Hill was signed by the Kansas City Royals on August 8<sup>th</sup> and assigned to the High-A Carolina League's Wilmington Blue Rocks. Hill is 29-for-72 (.403) in his first 21 games with Wilmington.
