WINNIPEG GOLDEYES (20-14) vs. FARGO-MOORHEAD REDHAWKS (12-22)

BULLPEN HELPS GOLDEYES HOLD OFF REDHAWKS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes beat the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks 6-4 at Newman Outdoor Field on Wednesday night. The Goldeyes served as the home team. Winnipeg took a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the second on a two-run single from Jordan George and an RBI single from Wes Darvill, both of which came with two outs. Fargo-Moorhead scored four runs in the top of the third on a Correlle Prime RBI single and a Drew Ward three-run home run. Logan Hill tied the game in the bottom of the third with an RBI double, and the Goldeyes regained the lead in the fifth on an Eric Wood RBI double. Hill made it 6-4 in the sixth with an RBI single. Nate Antone (2.0), Jose Jose (1.0), and Victor Capellan (1.0) combined for 4.0 shutout innings from the Goldeyes' bullpen. Kevin Hilton started and picked up the win, allowing four earned runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings. Hilton walked one and struck out one.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE REDHAWKS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 174-188 all-time against the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, including a 95-89 record in home games, and an 85-101 record at Newman Outdoor Field. The Goldeyes are 89-106 all-time at Newman Outdoor Field against all opponents. The RedHawks are celebrating their 25th season, and have been one of independent baseball's elite franchises since beginning play in 1996. The RedHawks won a Northern League record five championships (1998, 2003, 2006, 2009, and 2010) before joining the American Association in 2011 along with the Goldeyes, Gary SouthShore RailCats, and Kansas City T-Bones. Fargo-Moorhead won the American Association North Division in 2012 and 2013, and became the first team in league history to win 60-plus games in back-to-back seasons (65 wins in 2012, 62 wins in 2013). The 65 wins tied a then-American Association record, which has since been surpassed five times. The Goldeyes and RedHawks have clashed in the postseason 10 times, with the most recent meeting coming in the 2012 American Association Division Series. Former RedHawks' star Chris Coste was named interim manager in June. Coste was a member of the RedHawks' 1998 Northern League championship club before spending four seasons in the Major Leagues. Coste was a key member of the Philadelphia Phillies' 2008 World Series championship team. Coste takes over for James Bennett, who managed the RedHawks in 2019. During their 15 years in the Northern League, the RedHawks qualified for the postseason 14 times, made seven trips to the Northern League Championship Series, and never finished with a regular season winning percentage below .558.

SERIES MATCHUP: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 20-14 and in first place in the American Association. The Goldeyes were just swept in a three-game series by the Chicago Dogs at Newman Outdoor Field in which the Goldeyes served as the home team. The Goldeyes are tied for second in the American Association in hitting (.282), second in pitching (4.20), and tied for second in fielding (.976). The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks are 12-22, in sixth place, and 8.0 games behind Winnipeg. The RedHawks just lost two of three to the St. Paul Saints at CHS Field. The RedHawks are fourth in the league in batting (.272), sixth in pitching (5.14), and sixth in defence (.967). This is the fifth of seven head-to-head series between the Goldeyes and RedHawks this season. The Goldeyes were 7-5 against the RedHawks in 2019.

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: The Goldeyes go with right-hander Frank Duncan who is 4-2 with a 3.70 ERA in seven starts this season. Duncan is ninth in the American Association in ERA. Duncan took the loss vs. Chicago (played at Newman Outdoor Field) last Thursday, allowing six earned runs on nine hits in 5.2 innings. Duncan walked

none and struck out two. On July 21st at Fargo-Moorhead, Duncan earned his 50th career professional win.

Duncan was acquired from the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association dispersal draft on June 16th (Round 2, Pick 3). Duncan was 10-6 with a 3.05 ERA in 19 starts last season for the Can-Am League's Sussex County Miners. Duncan was tied for second in the Can-Am League in wins, third in ERA, third in strikeouts (111), first in innings pitched (132.2), and set a Can-Am League single-season record with eight complete games. On June 13th, Duncan pitched a nine-inning no-hitter over New Jersey Jackals, walking one and striking out six. On July 2nd, Duncan came within two outs of a seven-inning no-hitter vs. the Empire League All-Stars. Duncan allowed three or fewer earned runs in 14 of his 19 starts, and walked one or zero batters in 15 of them. Duncan was selected to the Can-Am League All-Star Team, and helped Sussex County reach the Can-Am League Championship Series.

Duncan is in his seventh season of professional baseball, and was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 13th round in 2014. Duncan is 51-46 lifetime with a 4.13 ERA in 144 games, 129 of them as a starting pitcher. Duncan has walked two batters or less in 116 of his 129 career starts, and has walked three batters or less in 125 of them. Duncan has reached the Triple-A level twice and the Double-A level three times during his career. Duncan pitched four seasons at the University of Kansas (Lawrence, Kansas) from 2011-14.

Duncan is 2-1 with a 3.04 ERA in four career starts against Fargo-Moorhead. Duncan is 3-2 with a 4.08 ERA in six career starts at Newman Outdoor Field.

The RedHawks go with left-hander Matthew Tomshaw who is 2-2 with a 3.66 ERA in six starts and one relief appearance this season. Tomshaw is eighth in the American Association in ERA. Tomshaw pitched a complete game win last Thursday at St. Paul, allowing two earned runs on eight hits in 9.0 innings. Tomshaw walked none and struck out five. Tomshaw has allowed three or fewer earned runs in five of his six starts this season. In his last four starts, Tomshaw is 2-1 with a 1.20 ERA in 30.0 innings pitched.

Tomshaw was a combined 9-7 with a 2.90 ERA in 17 starts and nine relief appearances last season, while pitching at two levels of the Chicago White Sox' organization. Tomshaw saw time with the Double-A Southern League's Birmingham Barons and the Triple-A International League's Charlotte Knights. Tomshaw combined for 118 strikeouts and just 20 walks in 111.2 innings pitched. Tomshaw has logged 111.2 or more innings in six of the past seven seasons, including a career-high 163.0 in 2017 for the Double-A Southern League's Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Miami Marlins).

Tomshaw was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 42nd round in 2011 out of Jacksonville University (Jacksonville, Florida). Tomshaw has four seasons of experience at the Triple-A level, and was in Major League spring training with the White Sox this March prior to the COVID-19 shutdown. Tomshaw posted a 3.00 ERA in 6.0 spring training innings with the White Sox. Tomshaw is in his 10th season of professional baseball, and is 68-57 lifetime with six saves and a 3.90 ERA in 233 games, 168 of them as a starting pitcher. Tomshaw has averaged just 1.8 walks per nine innings in 1,072.0 career innings pitched.

Tomshaw is 0-1 with a 3.32 ERA in three starts and one relief appearance in his career against Winnipeg. Tomshaw is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA in four starts and one relief appearance in his career at Newman Outdoor Field.

GOLDEYES MANAGER: Rick Forney is now in his 15th season as Goldeyes' manager, and his 24th overall within the organization. During his first 14 years at the helm, the Goldeyes have posted a .547 overall winning percentage (755-626), 11 winning seasons, nine playoff appearances, and an American Association-record three championships. Forney was voted American Association Manager of the Year in 2011, and managed the American Association during the American Association/Can-Am League All-Star Game in 2017. Forney's .555 winning percentage in the American Association (2011-19) is the fourth-highest in league history (there have been 56 total American Association managers through the 2019 season). Forney pitched professionally for 10 years, including four seasons with the Goldeyes. During his playing career, Forney was 89-56 (.614) with a 3.63 ERA, and reached the Triple-A level in 1995.

GOLDEYES WELCOME NEW HITTING COACH: The Winnipeg Goldeyes introduced Kash Beauchamp as their hitting coach last November. Beauchamp enjoyed a 14-year playing career in which he reached Triple-A in six different seasons. The former first overall draft pick (January phase, 1982) compiled a .285 career batting average in 1,083 professional games. In 1993, Beauchamp hit .367 for the Northern League's Rochester Aces (the franchise that eventually became the Winnipeg Goldeyes), and became the first position player in independent baseball history to have his contract purchased by a Major League organization (Cincinnati Reds). Beauchamp has 10 years of managerial experience in independent baseball, and currently serves as the independent leagues scout for the Arizona Diamondbacks.

CAPELLAN SETS AMERICAN ASSOCIATION SAVES RECORD: Goldeyes' relief pitcher Victor Capellan set the American Association career saves record on August 11th vs. Fargo-Moorhead in the second game of a double header. Capellan pitched a scoreless bottom of the seventh to preserve a 4-3 win for his 71st American Association save, passing the 70 amassed by left-hander Kris Regas (Sioux Falls, Kansas City). Capellan tied Regas with his 70th save on August 1st vs. St. Paul, also in the second game of a double header. On July 19th vs. Sioux Falls, Capellan recorded his 66th league save to pass right-hander Chris Thompson (Lincoln) for second place on the list. Capellan (along with current Goldeye Kevin McGovern) is one of just seven pitchers in franchise history to pitch five years with the team.

GOLDEYES ADD SEASONED HITTER PIZZANO: The Winnipeg Goldeyes signed outfielder Dario Pizzano prior to Tuesday's double header. Pizzano hit .286 with one home run and 14 RBI in 30 games earlier this season for the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks. Pizzano joins the Goldeyes with a .371 lifetime on-base percentage and an 11 percent strikeout rate. Pizzano has reached Triple-A twice and the Double-A level six times in his career. Fargo-Moorhead selected Pizzano from the Sioux City Explorers in the second round of the American Association Dispersal Draft on June 16th.

GOLDEYES ACQUIRE ODDO, TRADE MORALES: The Winnipeg Goldeyes acquired catcher Nick Oddo from the Frontier League's Schaumburg Boomers in exchange for a player to be named later on August 4th. Oddo has been a Frontier League All-Star each of the past two seasons, and hit .274 with five home runs and 34 RBI in 83 games for Schaumburg last year. The Goldeyes also traded catcher Roy Morales to the Sioux Falls Canaries in exchange for future considerations. Morales was hitting .333 with 10 RBI in 19 games, and was selected from the Kansas City T-Bones in the fifth round of the American Association Dispersal Draft on June 16th.

SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes announced several adjustments to their remaining schedule on Monday. The three-game series against the Milwaukee Milkmen from August 21st-23rd and September 8th-10th will now be played at Franklin Field in Franklin, Wisconsin. The three-game series against the St. Paul Saints from September 4th-6th will now be played at CHS Field in St. Paul, Minnesota. The nine games were originally scheduled to be played at Newman Outdoor Field. The Goldeyes will still serve as the home team in the nine games.

SWEENEY NAMED BATTER OF THE MONTH: Goldeyes' centre fielder Darnell Sweeney has been named the American Association Batter of the Month for July. In 25 games, Sweeney hit .330 with 23 runs scored, 11 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI, and six stolen bases. Sweeney has also seen action at shortstop and third base this season.

HOME ALONE: The St. Paul Saints were cleared to return to CHS Field on August 4th, leaving the Winnipeg Goldeyes as the lone 2020 American Association team playing exclusively on the road. The Goldeyes are playing their home games at Newman Outdoor Field, home of the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks. St. Paul played its first 12 home games at Sioux Falls Stadium, home of the Sioux Falls Canaries.

FILL IT UP: Goldeyes' pitchers have issued 73 walks in 34 games, which are the fewest in the American Association. The Goldeyes are averaging just 2.3 walks per nine innings.

MCGOVERN CHASING MOORE: Goldeyes' left-hander Kevin McGovern ranks second on the American Association's all-time strikeout list (652). Right-hander Ben Moore holds the record with 701.

RED LIGHT: Opposing base stealers have registered just 11 stolen base attempts against Goldeyes' catchers this season, which is fewest in the American Association. The Goldeyes are averaging just 0.32 stolen base attempts allowed per game. The American Association record is 0.69 attempts allowed per game, set by the 2018 Sioux City Explorers. The 2019 Goldeyes rank second on the list at 0.77 attempts allowed per game.

IN THE BIG INNING: The Goldeyes have had seven innings this season in which the opposition has scored five or more runs, which accounts for 49 of the 150 total runs allowed by the pitching staff. In the remaining 280.0 innings (101 runs allowed), the Goldeyes have averaged just 3.25 runs allowed per game.

DOUBLE UP: The Winnipeg Goldeyes have turned 36 double plays in their first 34 games of the season, which ranks first in the American Association. The Goldeyes set an American Association record in 2019 with a .987 team fielding percentage.

PLAY BALL: The American Association began its 2020 season on July 3rd. The league was originally scheduled to begin May 19th, but was delayed as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic. Six teams are scheduled to play 60 regular season games, including the Goldeyes, Chicago Dogs, Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, Milwaukee Milkmen, St. Paul Saints, and Sioux Falls Canaries. The teams with the best two winning percentages at the conclusion of the regular season will meet in the 2020 American Association Championship Series.

DRAFT DAY: With six American Association clubs inactive for the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 Pandemic (Cleburne Railroaders, Gary SouthShore RailCats, Kansas City T-Bones, Lincoln Saltdogs, Sioux City Explorers, and Texas AirHogs), the players signed to those rosters were made available in a dispersal draft which took place on June 16th. A total of 42 players were selected by the six participating teams, including nine by the Goldeyes. Eight of Winnipeg's nine picks made the Opening Night roster, including IF/OF Darnell Sweeney (Kansas City), RHP Frank Duncan (Kansas City), OF Jordan George (Kansas City), IF Thomas Walraven (Gary SouthShore), C Roy Morales (Kansas City), RHP Kent Hasler (Sioux City), RHP Ryan Flores (Sioux City), and C John Nester (Cleburne). The T-Bones had 17 players drafted off their roster, which was the most from a single team. All drafted players must be returned to their outgoing team at the conclusion of the 2020 season.

ROSTER RULES: As part of the adjusted 2020 American Association season, the league has waived its classification minimums and maximums. Previously, American Association clubs could carry a maximum of five veterans, and 11 total players classified LS-4 or above. Teams were also required to carry at least four (on a 22-man roster) or five (23-man roster) classified rookies. The classification rules are expected to return in 2021. Participating teams were also allowed to carry up to 25 players for the first 10 days of the season (13 of which must be pitchers) before paring down to the standard 23-man roster on July 13th.

GOLDEYES ENTER 27th SEASON: The Winnipeg Goldeyes enter their 27th season in 2020. The franchise brought professional baseball back to the city in 1994. The Goldeyes were 57-43 in 2019, marking the 22nd time in their first 26 years in which they finished with a winning record. The Goldeyes have reached the postseason 19 times, and have won four championships (Northern League 1994, American Association 2012, 2016, 2017).

ALUMNI REPORT: RHP Brandon Kintzler (2007-08) is currently signed with the Miami Marlins. Kintzler was an American League All-Star in 2017, saving 28 games for the Minnesota Twins. Kintzler has pitched in the Major Leagues every season since 2010. RHP Brandon Marklund signed with the Goldeyes in January of 2019 as a true rookie before having his contract purchased by the Kansas City Royals. Marklund posted a 0.46 ERA in 39.1 innings last season for the Low-A South Atlantic League's Lexington Legends. After joining the Goldeyes last June, outfielder Tyler Hill batted .375 for the Goldeyes in 40 games. Hill's contract was purchased by the Royals on August 8th. Hill then hit .403 in 21 games for the High-A Carolina League's Wilmington Blue Rocks, helping the club to a league championship.
