GOLDEYES CLIPPED BY REDHAWKS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes lost 4-2 to the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks at Shaw Park on Sunday afternoon. Alex Boxwell broke a scoreless tie with a two-out, solo home run in the top of the sixth. Nick Novak's two-out, RBI single in the seventh made it 2-0. The Goldeyes pulled within 2-1 in the bottom of the eighth when Tyler Hill's groundout to first resulted in a throwing error that scored Sonny Ulliana. Sam Dexter re-extended the RedHawks' lead with a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the ninth. The Goldeyes sliced the lead to 4-2 in the bottom of the ninth on a Logan Hill RBI single before Alex DuBord retired Amos Ramon on a lineout to right to strand the tying runs on base and earn his 11th save. Greg Harris started for the Goldeyes and took the loss, allowing one earned run on three hits in 5.2 innings. Harris walked three and struck out three.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE REDHAWKS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 180-204 all-time against the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, including a 99-95 record in home games, and a 77-84 record at Shaw Park. The RedHawks are celebrating their 25th anniversary in 2021, and have been one of independent baseball's elite franchises since beginning play in 1996. The RedHawks won a Northern League record five championships (1998, 2003, 2006, 2009, and 2010) before joining the American Association in 2011 along with the Goldeyes, Gary SouthShore RailCats, and Kansas City T-Bones. Fargo-Moorhead won the American Association North Division in 2012 and 2013, and became the first team in league history to win 60-plus games in back-to-back seasons (65 wins in 2012, 62 wins in 2013). The 65 wins tied a then-American Association record, which has since been surpassed five times. The Goldeyes and RedHawks have clashed in the postseason 10 times, with the most recent meeting coming in the 2012 American Association Division Series. Former RedHawks' star Chris Coste was named interim manager in June of 2020, and returns in a full-time role for his second season as Fargo's skipper. Coste was a member of the RedHawks' 1998 Northern League championship club before spending four seasons in the Major Leagues. Coste was a key member of the Philadelphia Phillies' 2008 World Series championship team. During their 15 years in the Northern League, the RedHawks qualified for the postseason 14 times, made seven trips to the Northern League Championship Series, and never finished with a regular season winning percentage below .558. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, the RedHawks hosted the Goldeyes for the majority of the season at Newman Outdoor Field where Winnipeg played 33 of their 60 games.

SERIES MATCHUP: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 50-48, in fourth place in the American Association North Division, and eliminated from postseason contention. The Goldeyes just won two of three from the Chicago Dogs at Shaw Park. The Goldeyes are fourth in the American Association in hitting (.283), 10th in pitching (5.78), and tied for fifth in fielding (.979). The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks are 60-38, in second place in the North, and will enter the postseason as the North Division's first wild card. The RedHawks just split a rain-shortened, two-game series against the Sioux City Explorers at Newman Outdoor Field. The RedHawks are first in the league in batting (.305), second in pitching (4.33), and second in defence (.982). This is the last of four head-to-head meetings this season between Winnipeg and Fargo-Moorhead. The Goldeyes were 13-11 against the RedHawks in 2020.

PROJECTED UPCOMING PITCHING MATCHUPS

End of 2021 Regular Season

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: The Goldeyes go with right-hander Eduard Reyes who is 7-8 with a 6.68 ERA in 19 starts and one relief appearance this season. Reyes took the loss vs. Chicago on Tuesday, allowing three earned runs on five hits in 5.0 innings. Reyes walked five and struck out four.

Reyes won the pitching triple crown for the All-American Baseball Challenge's New Jersey Jackals in 2020, going 4-1 with a 1.67 ERA and 53 strikeouts in 43.0 innings pitched. Reyes was 9-4 for the Can-Am League's New Jersey Jackals in 2019 where he ranked tied for fourth in the league in wins, eighth in ERA (3.71), 11th in strikeouts (88), and ninth in innings pitched (106.2). Reyes helped the Jackals win the 2019 Can-Am League championship, which proved to be the final championship in league history before the circuit merged with the Frontier League that off-season.

Reyes signed with the Milwaukee Brewers as an international free agent in 2010. Reyes is in his seventh season of professional baseball, and is 29-26 lifetime with a 4.15 ERA in 89 games, 69 of them as a starting pitcher.

Reyes is 0-1 with an 8.71 ERA in two career starts against Fargo-Moorhead. Reyes is 1-1 with a 2.95 ERA in three career starts at Shaw Park.

The RedHawks have not yet announced their starting pitcher.

GOLDEYES RETURN HOME: The Winnipeg Goldeyes returned to Shaw Park on Tuesday, August 3rd with a 14-6 win over the Sioux City Explorers. It marked the Goldeyes' first official home game since September 2nd, 2019, which was a span of 701 days. A total of 20 games over 19 home dates were added to the remaining schedule.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION POSTSEASON FORMAT ADJUSTED: On August 4th, the American Association announced an expanded playoff format. The top three teams in each division by winning percentage will now qualify for the postseason. The second- and third-place teams in each division will meet in a one-game playoff. The winner of the playoff game will face the winner from their own division in a best-of-five Division Series. The Division Series winners then meet in a best-of-five American Association Championship Series. The format originally called for the top two teams in each division qualifying for the postseason and immediately meeting in the Division Series.

99 GAMES: The second game of the scheduled double header on August 22nd between the Winnipeg Goldeyes and Kane County Cougars was cancelled due to rain. As per American Association rules, since August 22nd marked the final scheduled day of games between the clubs this season, the contest will not be made up. As a result, the Goldeyes can play a maximum of 99 games out of the 100 originally scheduled 2021. This marks only

the second time in the last 11 years in which the Goldeyes will fall short of a complete regular season schedule. The Goldeyes last fell short in 2015 when they played 99 out of 100 games. Prior to that, the Goldeyes had not lost a game from their schedule since 2010, which was their final season in the Northern League.

RECORD-SETTING YEAR FOR MARTIN: Goldeyes' first baseman Kyle Martin hit his 31st home run of the season on September 3rd vs. Fargo-Moorhead. The home run tied Keon Barnum (Chicago, 2019) and Adam Brett Walker (Milwaukee, 2021) for the American Association single-season record. The 31 home runs are also a new Goldeyes' single-season record, passing the 29 hit by Sean Hearn in 1998 and matched by Juan Diaz in 2009. Martin tied the Goldeyes' record with a walk-off home run on September 1st vs. Chicago, and broke the record the following night (September 2nd vs. Chicago). Walker hit his 32nd home run on September 5th to establish a new league record with one day remaining on the schedule.

Martin's home run on September 3rd also produced his 104th RBI of the season, which is a new American Association record. Cesar Nicolas (Grand Prairie, 2009) held the previous record with 103 RBI. Martin was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded later on in the September 3rd game, and his RBI total currently stands at 105. The Goldeyes' previous single-season RBI record was 90, set by Diaz in 2009. Martin tied Diaz with a pair of RBI doubles on August 12th at Chicago, and then set a new Goldeyes' record with his 91st RBI coming on a solo home run on August 13th at Kane County.

FAMOUS AMOS RETURNS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes signed infielder Amos Ramon on August 27th. Ramon, 38, returns after playing four seasons for the Goldeyes (2006, 2011-13). Ramon was the MVP of the 2012 American Association playoffs, helping the Goldeyes win their first championship since 1994.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Through 98 games, the Winnipeg Goldeyes are first in the American Association in doubles (201), and rank third in triples (24). The franchise records in those categories are 206 doubles in 2011 and 30 triples in 1999.

RUN PRODUCER: Goldeyes' first baseman Kyle Martin is first in the American Association with 105 RBI. Since July 1st, 2019, Martin has 206 RBI in his past 218 games as a member of the Goldeyes. Martin led the American Association with 51 RBI in 2020.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Goldeyes' outfielder Max Murphy is first in the American Association with 31 doubles, which ties a career-high set in 2018 with the St. Paul Saints. The Goldeyes' franchise record is 39 doubles set by Carmine Cappuccio in 2001.

WORKHORSE SEABROOKE: Goldeyes' left-handed pitcher Travis Seabrooke is tied for second in the American Association with 43 appearances, and trails Sioux City's Max Kuhns by one appearance for the league lead.

GRAND TIME COMING: Kyle Martin hit a grand slam home run on July 21st vs. Houston in the second game of a double header. It was the Goldeyes' first grand slam since Willy Garcia homered with the bases loaded on August 21st, 2019 at Chicago. Six days later, Martin hit a grand slam at Sioux City. Dakota Conners hit a walk-off grand slam on August 4th vs. Sioux City, giving Winnipeg three grand slam home runs in a 13-game span. Martin hit his third grand slam of the season (and the Goldeyes' fourth in 16 games) on August 7th vs. Milwaukee, which tied an American Association single-season record set by Garcia for Winnipeg in 2019.

TRIPLE THREAT: Goldeyes' infielder Kevin Lachance tied a franchise single-game record with two triples on June 16th at Cleburne. The record was last accomplished by Josh Romanski on July 2nd, 2016 vs. Sioux Falls.

STEADY PRESENCE: Goldeyes' infielder Raul Navarro had a career-high 18-game hitting streak end on July 16th at Fargo-Moorhead. Navarro has also had streaks of nine and 14 games this season. Navarro has hit safely in 68 of the 86 games he has started this season, and has reached with a hit, walk, or hit by pitch in 81 of them.

DOUBLE DOWN: Following their double header on August 24th at Milwaukee, the Winnipeg Goldeyes officially played their 10th double header of 2021 which is a new franchise record. The Goldeyes are 4-3-3 in those double headers. The previous record was nine double headers in 2009. The pandemic-shortened 2020 season now ranks third with seven double headers. Winnipeg had a potential 11th double header scheduled on August 22nd vs. Kane County, but the second game was cancelled due to rain.

TENNESSEE BOUND: Due to the closure of the Canada/US border, the Winnipeg Goldeyes partnered with the Jackson Generals professional baseball club to host Winnipeg at The Ballpark Jackson at the beginning of the 2021 season. The Goldeyes played 33 (18-15) games in Jackson, Tennessee and anticipate a return to Shaw Park in Winnipeg on August 3rd. The Generals were a Double-A Southern League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, Seattle Mariners, and Arizona Diamondbacks from 1998-2019. The franchise hosted the Southern League All-Star Game on two occasions, and won four Southern League championships.

EYES ON THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION: Since the start of training camp on May 6th, the American Association has sold the contracts of 52 players to Major League organizations. The Goldeyes have had four players picked up since then, including RHP Ryan Dull (Seattle Mariners), RHP Josh Lucas (Arizona Diamondbacks), IF Alexis Pantoja (Arizona Diamondbacks), and RHP Cory Thompson (St. Louis Cardinals).

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION BACK TO FULL STRENGTH: The American Association returns to 12 teams and a 100-game schedule in 2021. The league is split into two divisions.

ROSTER RULES RETURN, ADJUSTED: After waiving all classification restrictions in 2020, the American Association returns to its traditional roster rules in 2021. Teams may carry up to 11 players classified as LS-4. Seven of those 11 may be LS-5 or higher, while five of them may be classified as veterans. Teams must carry at least five classified rookies on a full, 25-man roster (four rookies if carrying 22 players, or three rookies if carrying 21 players). The American Association recently announced that teams may carry up to 25 players for the entire 2021 season, up from 23 players in previous years.

GOLDEYES ENTER 28th SEASON: The Winnipeg Goldeyes enter their 28th season in 2021. The franchise brought professional baseball back to the city in 1994. The Goldeyes have finished with a winning record in 22 of their first 27 seasons. The Goldeyes have reached the postseason 19 times, and have won four championships (Northern League 1994, American Association 2012, 2016, 2017).

ALUMNI REPORT: RHP Brandon Kintzler (2007-08) is currently signed with the Philadelphia Phillies. Kintzler has pitched in the Major Leagues every season since 2010. RHP Brandon Marklund signed with the Goldeyes as a true rookie in 2019 before having his contract purchased by the Kansas City Royals. RHP Kent Hasler pitched for the Goldeyes in 2020 after the Goldeyes selected him from the Sioux City Explorers in the American Association dispersal draft. Hasler signed with the Milwaukee Brewers in May and was assigned to the Low-A East's Carolina Mudcats. RHP Frank Duncan (2020) was signed by the Colorado Rockies while a member of the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, and is currently pitching for the Double-A Northeast's Hartford Yard Goats. RHP Cory Thompson (2021) was signed by the St. Louis Cardinals on June 10th.
