REDHAWKS RIDE BIG SECOND TO EVEN SERIES: The Winnipeg Goldeyes lost 8-3 to the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks in Game Two of the American Association Division Series at Newman Outdoor Field on Friday night. Fargo-Moorhead opened a 5-0 lead in the bottom of the second on a two-run home run from John Silviano, a wild pitch, and a two-out, two-run home run from Peter Maris. Manuel Boscan scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the fifth to make it 6-0. Ian Sagdal led off the top of the sixth with a home run to put the Goldeyes on the board, but the RedHawks answered in the bottom half on a solo home run from Alec Olund. Michael Crouse pulled Winnipeg within 7-3 with a two-run homer in the top of the seventh. The RedHawks scored the game's final run in the bottom of the eighth on a Boscan fielder's choice. Luis Ramirez started for the Goldeyes and took the loss, allowing six earned runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings. Ramirez walked one and struck out eight.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE REDHAWKS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are 185-212 all-time against the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, including a 101-100 record in home games, and a 79-89 record at Shaw Park. The RedHawks celebrated their 25th anniversary in 2021, and have been one of independent baseball's elite franchises since beginning play in 1996. The RedHawks won a Northern League record five championships (1998, 2003, 2006, 2009, and 2010) before joining the American Association in 2011 along with the Goldeyes, Gary

SouthShore RailCats, and Kansas City T-Bones. Fargo-Moorhead won the American Association North Division in 2012 and 2013, and became the first team in league history to win 60-plus games in back-to-back seasons (65 wins in 2012, 62 wins in 2013). The 65 wins in 2012 tied a then-American Association record, which has since been surpassed six times. The Goldeyes and RedHawks have clashed in the postseason 10 times, with the most recent meeting coming in the 2012 American

Association Division Series. Former RedHawks' star Chris Coste is in his third season as Fargo-Moorhead's manager. Coste was a member of the RedHawks' 1998 Northern League championship club before spending four seasons in the Major Leagues. Coste was a key member of the Philadelphia Phillies' 2008 World Series championship team. During their 15 seasons in the Northern League, the RedHawks qualified for the postseason 14 times, made seven trips to the Northern League Championship Series, and never finished with a regular season winning percentage below .558. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, the RedHawks hosted the Goldeyes for the majority of the season at Newman Outdoor Field where the Goldeyes played 33 of their 60 scheduled games. 2022 marks the fifth time the RedHawks have won 60-plus games in the American Association, which ties the Wichita Wingnuts for the most in league history.

SERIES MATCHUP: The Winnipeg Goldeyes were 53-47 in the regular season, and finished in third place in the American Association West Division. The Goldeyes won three of four from the Sioux Falls Canaries at Shaw Park in their final regular season series. The Goldeyes were sixth in the American Association in hitting (.271), fifth in pitching (4.80), and tied for seventh in fielding (.977). The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks were 64-36, and finished in second place in the West. The RedHawks lost three of four to the Kansas City Monarchs at Legends Field to close out the regular season. The RedHawks were third in the league in batting (.279), third in pitching (4.52), and first in defence (.986). The Goldeyes were 5-7 against the RedHawks in the regular season across four series.

PROJECTED UPCOMING PITCHING MATCHUPS

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: The Goldeyes go with right-hander Freisis Adames who was 8-4 with a 5.07 ERA in 15 starts and two relief appearances during the regular season. Adames picked up the win vs. Sioux Falls on Sunday, allowing two earned runs on four hits in 5.0 innings. Adames walked none and struck out six. Adames allowed three or fewer earned runs in 10 of his

15 regular season starts, and allowed four or fewer earned runs in 12 of them.

Adames was 5-2 with a 5.57 ERA in nine starts and 17 relief appearances last season for the High-A Central's Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee Brewers). Adames struck out 75 in 82.1 innings. Adames allowed four or fewer earned runs in eight of his nine starts. Adames signed with the Brewers as an international free agent in 2015 and is in his sixth season of professional baseball. Adames is 26-17 lifetime with three saves and a 4.26 ERA in 107 games, 51 of them as a starting pitcher. Adames has averaged 8.4 strikeouts per nine innings as a professional.

Adames is 1-0 with an 8.10 ERA in two career starts against Fargo-Moorhead. Tonight will be Adames' first career appearance at Newman Outdoor Field.

The RedHawks go with rookie left-hander Peyton Wigginton who was 9-3 with one save and a 3.84 ERA in 14 starts and one relief appearance during the regular season. Wigginton tied for eighth in the American Association in wins, was seventh in ERA, and tied for 17th among pitchers with 1.9 wins above replacement. Wigginton allowed three or fewer earned runs in 10 of his 14 regular season starts, and allowed four or fewer earned runs in 13 of them.

Wigginton was 6-5 with one save and a 4.44 ERA in 11 starts and eight relief appearances as a senior this past spring at Middle Tennessee State University (Murfreesboro, Tennessee). Wigginton pitched five seasons for the Blue Raiders from 2018-22, and ranks fourth on the program's career strikeout list with 259 over 318.0 collegiate innings. During his sophomore season in 2019, Wigginton served as a two-way player, hitting .289 with two home runs and 14 RBI in 96 plate appearances.

Wigginton is 3-0 with a 3.79 ERA in three career starts against Winnipeg. Wigginton is 4-2 with one save and a 4.83 ERA in eight starts and one relief appearance in his career at Newman Outdoor Field.

GOLDEYES MANAGER: Rick Forney completes his 17th season as Goldeyes' manager and 27th overall within the organization. Through the 2022 season with Forney at the helm, the Goldeyes have posted a .541 overall winning percentage (887-753), 13 winning seasons, 10 playoff appearances, and an American Association-record three championships. Forney was voted American Association Manager of the Year in 2011 and again in 2020. Forney pitched professionally for 10 years, including four seasons with the Goldeyes. During his playing career, Forney was 89-56 (.614) with a 3.63 ERA, and reached the Triple-A level in 1995.

GOLDEYES IN WINNER-TAKE-ALL GAMES: Tonight marks the 15th winner-take-all postseason game in Goldeyes' history. The Goldeyes are 7-7 all-time in those games, including a 4-6 record on the road. The Goldeyes last played a winner-take-all game in Game Five of the 2017 American Association Championship Series, beating the Wichita Wingnuts 18-2. This is the sixth time the Goldeyes are facing the RedHawks in a winner-take-all, and the first since Game Five of the 2009 Northern League Division Series. The Goldeyes are 2-3 against the RedHawks in winner-take-all games.

GOLDEYES DRAW REDHAWKS IN FIRST ROUND OF PLAYOFFS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes are facing the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks in the best-of-three American Association Division series. By virtue of clinching the American Association West Division on Monday, the Kansas City Monarchs selected the Lincoln Saltdogs as their first-round playoff opponent, setting up the matchup between the Goldeyes and RedHawks. This marks the 11th postseason meeting all-time between Winnipeg and Fargo-Moorhead, and the first since the 2012 American Association Division Series. The winners of the Winnipeg/Fargo-Moorhead series and the Kansas City/Lincoln series meet in the best-of-three West Division Championship Series. The winner of that series will then meet the winner of the East Division Championship Series in the best-of-five Miles Wolff Cup Finals.

MURPHY VOTED LEAGUE'S BEST: Winnipeg Goldeyes' outfielder Max Murphy was voted the American Association's 2022 Player of the Year. Murphy hit .308, while leading the league in both home runs (31) and RBI (97). The 31 home runs tied a Goldeyes' single-season record and rank tied for second in the American Association history. Murphy is the fourth Goldeye (fifth time overall) to win league MVP honours, joining Terry Lee (1995 and 1996, Northern League), Sean Hearn (1998, Northern League), and Josh Romanski (2017, American Association).

TRIO OF GOLDEYES VOTED POSTSEASON ALL-STARS: Goldeyes' outfielder Max Murphy, shortstop Raul Navarro, and first baseman David Washington were all voted to the American Association Postseason All-Star Team. Murphy led the American Association in home runs (31) and RBI (97) during the regular season. Washington ranked second in home runs (30) and tied for eighth in RBI (80). Navarro finished sixth in batting average (.335)

GOLDEYES CLINCH PLAYOFF BERTH: With their win in game one of a double header on August 27th at Fargo-Moorhead, the Winnipeg Goldeyes clinched a berth in the 2022 American Association playoffs. It marks the 20th playoff berth in franchise history, which is the most of any team in independent baseball since the industry began in 1993.

GOLDEYES CLINCH WINNING RECORD: The Winnipeg Goldeyes won their 51st game of the season on September 2nd vs. Sioux Falls. The win clinched a winning record for the 24th time in 29 seasons since the Goldeyes began play in 1994. The 24 winning seasons are the most of any independent team since the industry began in 1993, and trail only the New York Yankees and Los Angeles Dodgers at any level of professional baseball during that time.

MURPHY, WASHINGTON JOIN EXCLUSIVE CLUB: Max Murphy hit his 30th home run of the season on August 29th vs. Kansas City. David Washington hit his 30th on September 2nd vs. Sioux Falls. Murphy and Washington are just the fifth and sixth players in American Association history to reach the 30-home run benchmark, and are the first teammates to accomplish the feat. CJ Ziegler hit 30 home runs for the Wichita Wingnuts in 2013. Keon Barnum blasted 31 for the Chicago Dogs in 2019. Adam Brett Walker (33, Milwaukee) and Kyle Martin (31, Winnipeg) each joined the club in 2021.

GOLDEYES GOIN' DEEP, SET FRANCHISE RECORD: The Winnipeg Goldeyes set a franchise record, hitting 136 home runs in 100 games in 2022. On August 23rd at Kansas City, Raul Navarro hit the Goldeyes' 124th home run of the season, breaking the franchise record of 123 set in 1998. Reggie Pruitt Jr. hit the first grand slam of his professional career on May 19th vs. Sioux Falls, and has hit a career-high 13 home runs this season (previous career-high was three). Navarro hit an inside-the-park home run on June 17th vs. Lincoln. David Washington homered twice in the same inning (bottom second) on July 10th vs. Sioux City, and hit his first career right-handed home run on July 19th at Chicago. Rookie Justin Thompson hit his first career home run on July 10th vs. Sioux City, and hit his first career grand slam on August 2nd at Sioux Falls. Max Murphy hit three home runs in game one of a double header on August 27th at Fargo-Moorhead, becoming the first Goldeye to accomplish the feat since Mason Katz on September 4th, 2017. Murphy hit his 31st of the season on August 31st vs. Kansas City to tie the Goldeyes' single-season record. David Washington hit his 30th on September 2nd vs. Sioux Falls, marking the first time in American Association history two 30-home run hitters played on the same team. 2022 marked the sixth time in franchise history a Goldeyes' offence has reached 100 or more home runs in a season.

GOLDEYES SET FRANCHISE STRIKEOUT RECORD: Travis Seabrooke struck out Sam Dexter on August 28th at Fargo-Moorhead for the Goldeyes' 752nd strikeout of the season, setting a new franchise record. The 2017 Winnipeg Goldeyes struck out 751 batters. The Goldeyes finished the 2022 season with a team record 809 strikeouts.

1,000 HIT CLUB: Goldeyes' first baseman David Washington recorded his 1,000th career professional base hit with a single leading off the top of the sixth inning in the second game of a double header on August 27th at Fargo-Moorhead. Washington is in his 14th season of professional baseball, and was drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 15th round in 2009. Washington reached the Major Leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 2017.

MURPHY TIES FRANCHISE RECORD: Max Murphy finished the 2022 season with 31 home runs, which ties Kyle Martin (2021) for the Goldeyes' single-season record. David Washington hit 30 home runs this season, and now ranks third, passing Sean Hearn (1998) and Juan Diaz (2009) who are now tied for fourth with 29.

ARM AND HAMMER: In addition to hitting 31 home runs, Goldeyes' outfielder Max Murphy recorded his 10th outfield assist of the season on August 18th vs. Kansas City. The 10th assist marked the highest total by a Goldeyes' outfielder since Chris Kokinda tallied 11 in 1999. In 2021, Murphy had nine outfield assists, which was the most by a Goldeye since Carmine Cappuccio had nine in 2001. The Goldeyes' single-season record is 14 outfield assists, held by Brent Watts in 1996. Murphy finished the 2022 season with 12 assists, which tied Lincoln's Hunter Clanin for the most in the American Association. Murphy also made seven appearances as a relief pitcher, striking out seven in 6.0 innings.

SEABROOKE TIES RECORD: Goldeyes' left-handed pitcher Travis Seabrooke made his 60th appearance of the season on September 5th vs. Sioux Falls. The 60 appearances tie the American Association and Goldeyes' single-season record set by Jack Charleston in 2018. Seabrooke tied for the league lead with 44 appearances in 2021, despite being away from the team for two weeks while playing for Team Canada.

RED LIGHT GOLDEYES: The Winnipeg Goldeyes allowed 104 stolen base attempts during the 2022 season, which were the fewest in the American Association (average of 1.04 attempts per game by the opposition). The Goldeyes hold the American Association record for lowest average stolen base attempts against at 0.47 during the 60-game 2020 season.

BRICK WALL GOLDEYES: Goldeyes' catchers Deon Stafford Jr. and Hidekel Gonzalez combined to catch all 860.0 innings of the 2022 season, and set an American Association record by not allowing a passed ball. The previous record was two passed balls by the 2014 Wichita Wingnuts and the 2015 Winnipeg Goldeyes.

STROBEL REACHES 20 SAVES: Goldeyes' left-handed pitcher Tasker Strobel earned his 20th save of the season on August 13th vs. Sioux City. Strobel is just the fifth pitcher in franchise history to reach 20 saves in a season, and it marks only the sixth time a Goldeye has achieved the milestone. The other four Goldeyes to earn 20-plus saves are Steve Thomas (20, 2001), Oscar Montero (22, 2004), Ryan Chaffee (21, 2017), and Victor Capellan (22, 2018 and 27, 2019).

NAVARRO POSTS CAREER-HIGH STREAK: Goldeyes' infielder Raul Navarro ran off a career-high 24-game hitting streak from June 29th-August 4th. Navarro hit .420 (42-for-100) during the streak, which was the longest in the American Association in 2022. Navarro's previous best was an 18-game hitting streak set with the Goldeyes in 2021 (26-for-68, .382 from June 26th-July 14th). The streak is the longest by a Goldeye since Kody Kaiser hit safely in 22 straight in 2012, and ends three games shy of the franchise record of 27 (Luis Ortiz in 2001 and Brent Metheny in 2008).

MURPHY AND WASHINGTON REACH BENCHMARK: Max Murphy hit his 20th home run of the season on July 19th at Chicago, becoming the 17th player in franchise history to reach the milestone. David Washington hit his 20th on July 26th vs. Chicago. It marked the third time in franchise history the Goldeyes have had two 20-home run hitters in the same season. Sean Hearn (29) and Tony Chance (20) reached the benchmark in 1998, while Brent Metheny (21) and Walter Young (21) accomplished the feat in 2007. Murphy (31) and Washington (30) each finished with 30-plus home runs, becoming the first teammates to do so in American Association history.

RAMIREZ REACHES 100 STRIKEOUTS: Goldeyes' starting pitcher Luis Ramirez recorded his 100th strikeouts of the season on August 3rd at Sioux Falls. Ramirez is the 17th pitcher in franchise history (25th time overall) to strike out 100 or more batters in a single season, and the first since Mitchell Lambson (133) in 2019. Ramirez finished the regular season with 133 strikeouts, which tie Mitchell Lambson for third on the Goldeyes' single-season list.

CONSECUTIVE SHUTOUTS: The Winnipeg Goldeyes posted back-to-back shutouts on July 7th at Fargo-Moorhead (1-0) and July 8th vs. Sioux City (9-0). It marked the sixth time in franchise history the Goldeyes pitched shutouts in consecutive games, and the first since pitching three straight shutouts from August 30th-September 1st in 2017.

COMPLETE ME: Starting pitcher Alex Manasa pitched a complete game victory at Lincoln on June 25th in the second game of a double header. It was the first complete game by a Goldeyes' starter since Frank Duncan pitched a complete game loss on September 9th, 2020 in the second game of a double header. Prior to Manasa, the Goldeyes' last complete game victory was by Kevin McGovern on August 1st, 2020 vs. St. Paul (played at Newman Outdoor Field) in game one of a double header. The last Goldeye to pitch a 9.0-inning complete game is Kevin Hilton, who earned the win on August 26th, 2019 at Fargo-Moorhead.

SLIM MARGIN: The Winnipeg Goldeyes beat the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks 1-0 at Newman Outdoor Field on July 7th. It marked the 30th 1-0 game in franchise history (29 regular season, one postseason), and the first for the Goldeyes since beating the Milwaukee Milkmen 1-0 at Franklin Field on August 9th, 2019 in the second game of a double header. It was the fourth time the Goldeyes and RedHawks played a 1-0 game.

RETURN TO NORMAL: For the first time since 2019, the Goldeyes played a full schedule of games at Shaw Park in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The Goldeyes participated in the American Association's abbreviated, 60-game season in 2020, but played exclusively outside of Winnipeg and were primarily based out of Fargo, North Dakota. The Goldeyes played a full schedule in 2021, but played the majority of their home games in Jackson, Tennessee, former home of the Double-A Southern League's Jackson Generals. The Goldeyes finally returned to Shaw Park on August 3rd and hosted 19 true home dates to close the season. Prior to August 3rd, 2021, the Goldeyes went 701 calendar days without a home game at Shaw Park.

DIVISION REALIGNMENT: After splitting the league into North and South Divisions from 2018-21, the American Association has shifted to an East/West format for 2022. The Goldeyes are now members of the American Association West, and are joined by the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks, Kansas City Monarchs, Lincoln Saltdogs, Sioux City Explorers, and Sioux Falls Canaries. All six clubs in the West have lineage tied back to the earliest days of modern independent baseball. The East Division is comprised of the Chicago Dogs, Cleburne Railroaders, Gary SouthShore RailCats, Kane County Cougars, expansion Lake Country DockHounds, and Milwaukee Milkmen.

POSTSEASON FIELD: In addition to divisional realignment, the American Association introduced a new playoff format in 2022. The top four teams (by winning percentage) in each division qualify for the postseason. Each division will then host two best-of-three series to determine the participants in the best-of-five American Association Finals. Seeding for the first round will be determined by the first-place finisher in each division having the opportunity to choose their opponent.

DOCKED UP: The American Association welcomes the Lake Country DockHounds as an expansion team in 2022. The club is located in Oconomowoc, Wisconsin (pronounced uh-KAHN-uh-muh-wok), a suburb 35 miles west of downtown Milwaukee. The DockHounds are also just 38 miles northwest of Franklin, Wisconsin, home of the American Association's Milwaukee Milkmen. Lake Country is set to play at state-of-the-art Wisconsin Brewing Company Park, which the Goldeyes helped unveil on May 20th. The DockHounds replace the Houston Apollos who served as a traveling team in 2021.

LEAGUE ROSTER RULES ADJUSTED: The American Association adjusted its roster rules for the 2022 season. Teams may carry 25 active players throughout the entire regular season and postseason. Teams can also carry up to six veteran players (up from five in previous seasons). The five-rookie minimum has been changed to include both rookie and LS-1 classifications. Teams may fill out their remaining roster spots with any number of LS-2, LS-3, LS-4, and LS-5 classified players. Previously, teams were limited to 11 total players classified LS-4 or higher.

ALUMNI REPORT: RHP Kent Hasler (2020) had a 2.04 ERA in 14 appearances for the High-A Midwest League's Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee Brewers), and recently made his first career appearance at the Triple-A level. Hasler is currently with the Double-A Southern League's Biloxi Shuckers. Kyle Martin (2019-21) opened the season with the Mexican League's Guerreros de Oaxaca and hit .364 with 18 home runs and 47 RBI in 39 games. Martin's Mexican League contract was recently purchased by the San Diego Padres where he was assigned to the Triple-A Pacific Coast League's El Paso Chihuahuas. RHP Cory Thompson (2021) has a 5.40 ERA in 10 games for the Double-A Texas League's Springfield Cardinals (St. Louis Cardinals). RHP Frank Duncan (2020) has made six starts for the Triple-A Pacific Coast League's Albuquerque Isotopes (Colorado Rockies). OF

Tyler Hill (2019, 2021) is also currently with Double-A Eastern League's Hartford (Colorado Rockies), and recently picked up his first career Triple-A hit while with Albuquerque.
